Nursery Education Grant for three and four year olds

The Little Conkers Nursery operates term time only, from Monday to Friday between 8:30am and 3:20pm with the provision for early morning drop off at 8:00am and afterschool until 6:00pm.

Early Years Entitlement

All children are entitled to receive 15 hours per week, funded by the Government, the term following their 3rd birthday. At St John's Priory we accept the Early Education Funding (EEF) for 15 hours and 30 hours per week until the end of the school term in which a child is due to join the Reception class.

How do I prove I am eligible for 30 hour funding?

You will need to apply through the digital childcare service that you will find on the following website, www.childcarechoices.gov.uk. If you are eligible you will need to provide us with your 30 hour eligibility code.

What the Code's Three Dates Mean:

From Date (1st Date):

If the code was issued between Sept - Dec - the earliest start date is Jan

If the code was issued between Jan - Mar - the earliest start date is Apr

If the code was issued between Apr – Aug - the earliest start date is Sept

To Date (2nd Date): Is the date the parent must reconfirm by.

Grace Period (3rd Date): This is the Grace Period end date. This is the potential date that the child could be funded up to if they fall out of eligibility. If they are in the Grace Period they will not receive the Extended Hours funding if they change provider, or if they didn't claim the Extended Hours in the previous term. A child cannot start the 30 funded hours until the term after the code was issued AND the term after the child turns three.


Please be mindful that if your code expires or if you become ineligible you will be charged full fees from the expiration date.

Can I just have free sessions?

Yes within the accordance of our session times and availability.

What proportion of the grant can I claim?

The grant entitlement allows you to claim all your funding here at Little Conkers Nursery.



Little Conkers Nursery School Fees:

| Session | | Cost of session |
|-----------------|----------------------------|-----------------|
| Morning | 8:30am – 1.15pm (4 hrs) | £30 |
| School Day | 8:30am – 3.20pm (7 hrs) | £52 |
| Long School Day | 8:30am – 6pm (9.5 hrs) | £64 |

Our hourly rate is £7.43 for additional hours.

The **15 free hours** of funding must be used over the course of three mornings (8.30am - 1.15pm) and **30 free hours** can be any combination of hours (*subject to availability*) between 8:30am and 6:00pm daily. Sessions are booked termly in advance and any additional hours are charged at **£7.43 per hour** during the school day or our afterschool rates as per the main fees and charges.

30 hour funded only places are limited and are given at the Headmistress's discretion.

We have agreed 1 collection time during the school day to help minimize disruption for the children. These are booked and charged termly in advance - refunds are not given for early collection and you will be charged for any additional hours
